

## **Explanation of Family Planning Expenditure Categories & Source of Information**

**Site-Level:** Activities that occur at the point of service delivery or facility level and are categorized by the implementation of FP activities in specific communities or facilities. This includes both direct FP services to beneficiaries and non-service delivery (technical assistance, site-level training, mentoring and supervision) at the site/community level.

**Above-Site Level:** Activities that support the broader FP program or the health system, including program management, strategic information, surveillance, and health systems strengthening.
